- If you have the Bendigo Bank app installed on your mobile phone or tablet, you can receive a notification when your e-statement is ready, prompting you to view it straight away.
- You can save your e-statements to your computer, phone or tablet so you can refer to them in the future.
- Your e-statements are password protected, making them more secure than paper statements.

Already registered for online banking?

Follow these simple steps to opt out of paper statements and switch to e-statements.

1. Log in to the Bendigo Bank app or Bendigo Bank e-banking via our secure website on your laptop or computer.
2. Choose 'Settings'.
3. Choose 'Statement preferences'. Here, you'll find a list of your accounts indicating whether they receive paper or e-statements.
4. Turn off the option to receive paper statements by clicking the On/Off toggle at the top of the page.
5. Add an email address to receive notifications for new e-statements. You can add up to three email addresses for this purpose.
6. Select 'Save'.

To switch to e-statements you first need to register for online banking.
