Celebrating our 12th birthday

Looking back on our history

Volunteer Director Terri Bateman reflects on the history of our company and the establishment of Community Bank Aspendale Gardens-Edithvale,

In 2006, a number of local business people, in association with the Rotary Club of Aspendale, met to discuss their concerns that there was no bank branch in the suburbs of Edithvale, Aspendale or Aspendale Gardens.

Led by Ray Smith and David Newbold, a committee was formed to assess the feasibility of a Community Bank in the area. After preliminary discussions with Bendigo Bank, a firm of accountants was commissioned to engage with the local community on the prospect of establishing a branch and the recommendation was made that it be established at the Aspendale Gardens Shopping Centre.

The local committee, in conjunction with Bendigo Bank then carried out a comprehensive due diligence process, which included sending questionnaires to local residents to ascertain their views on the establishment of a Community Bank.

John Bainbridge joined the committee in 2008 and was instrumental in securing the support needed to move forward. At a public meeting at the Aspendale Gardens Primary School in early 2009, the committee resolved to proceed to establish Community Bank Aspendale Gardens-Edithvale.

Later in 2009, the committee set up a public company, AGECOM Enterprises Limited, with Ray Smith as chairman. A prospectus was issued on 30 September 2009. A Public Offer was opened on 12 October 2009 and closed on 12 November 2009. Shares were allotted on 30 November 2009, and share certificate issued on 15 December 2009. The prospectus had aimed for 710,000 shares at \$1.00 each, but in fact 741,909 shares were subscribed for.

Operating under a franchise agreement with Bendigo and Adelaide Bank, Community Bank Aspendale Gardens-Edithvale opened it's doors 14 May 2010.

Celebrations for our ten year anniversary unfortunately coincided with the COVID-19 pandemic, so we postponed, and celebrated 12 years in the community in May 2022 instead. Thank you to our loyal customers, shareholders and board directors (past and present) who came along in May to celebrate our birthday.
