## **Driving local impact**

Our commitment to community support goes beyond words – we take action by partnering with initiatives that create meaningful change. One shining example of this is the Driving the Future program in the City of Victor Harbor.



This initiative provides

young people with a dedicated vehicle, funded by Community Bank Fleurieu, to help them achieve their provisional driver's licences. Many youths do not have access to a supervising driver, which often limits their ability to reach independence, employment, and future opportunities. The Driving the Future program fills this vital gap, giving eligible young people free access to a roadworthy vehicle and qualified supervision.

What we love about this program is that it is more than just driving lessons; it builds lasting relationships, creates community connections, and empowers young people to achieve their goals.

Program coordinator Daniel Western highlighted the importance of Community Bank Fleurieu's support, saying, "Without the \$35,000 from Community Bank Fleurieu, this program wouldn't have been possible." The impact of the bank's contribution goes beyond the monetary value; it is changing lives and building community cohesion.

As Tianni Cameron, one of the learner drivers, put it, "Without this program, I don't know how I would have gotten my supervised hours." We are so proud to play a part in this meaningful journey – empowering young people and supporting community growth, one drive at a time.



# Supporting our community: The Fleurieu Accommodation Project

The Fleurieu Accommodation Project is a powerful testament to our commitment to creating meaningful change in the community. This groundbreaking \$70,000 initiative, in collaboration with the Fleurieu Community Foundation, Zonta Club of the Fleurieu Peninsula, Elders Real Estate Victor Harbor and Junction Australia, is helping secure much-needed relief for those facing homelessness across the Fleurieu Peninsula.

The project, spearheaded by Junction, focuses on addressing the urgent need for safe and accessible housing. As the head leaseholder, Junction leases private rental properties and sublets them to individuals experiencing, or at risk of, homelessness. This approach provides both immediate support and a pathway to stability for vulnerable members of our community.

Our role has been integral in bringing this project to life, with key members of our team – Alison Burr, Julie Zeitinger, and Natalie Stevenson – actively participating over the past year. Their dedication and our Goolwa branch's commitment, utilising staff investment grants, have played a crucial part in seeing this vision become a reality.

The Fleurieu Accommodation Project is more than providing a roof – it's about building resilience, dignity, and community connections. As Brad Butler, CEO of Fleurieu Community Foundation, put it, "Together, we are making a profound difference and building a stronger, more resilient Fleurieu."

We are incredibly proud to be part of this transformative project, working side by side with local partners to uplift those in need. This is what community banking is all about – making a positive impact right here, where we live and work.

# Grants, bears, and auctions: A celebration of community spirit



On Thursday, 14 November, the spirit of community filled the air at Connect Victor as over 100 people gathered to celebrate and support local initiatives. Hosted by Community Bank Fleurieu, the Community Investment Evening was more than just an event - it was a celebration of collaboration, generosity, and community spirit.

A highlight of the night was the announcement of \$133,000 in Community Grants awarded to 14 different local organisations by Community Bank Fleurieu. From supporting grassroots initiatives to empowering regional programs, the grants will bring tangible benefits to the people of the Fleurieu Peninsula, enabled by those who bank with Community Bank Fleurieu.

Among the recipients was a special grant of \$50,000 dedicated to the 2025 Kangaroo Island Future Leaders Program. Supported through the Bendigo Bank 2019/2020 Adelaide Hills & Kangaroo Island Bushfire Appeal, this investment signifies a commitment to future growth and resilience on the Island, and further connects

the Kangaroo Island community with that of the Fleurieu.

But the evening wasn't just about grants - it was also about conversation, laughter and a sense of fun. Buttoned Up Co took centre stage



with an impromptu auction, sparking friendly bidding, particularly between the Mayor of the City of Victor Harbor and the new CEO of Alexandrina Council.

Thanks to their generosity, \$440 was raised - matched by Community Bank Fleurieu, making the final amount \$880. These funds will support Buttoned Up Co, a not-for-profit organisation dedicated to providing bedding comforts like pyjamas and blankets for those in need, helping to bring warmth and comfort to those in difficult circumstances.

Every customer of Community Bank Fleurieu helps change lives and save lives. By investing 80% of their profits into local initiatives, the bank's commitment to giving back remains unwavering. It was mentioned more than once how grateful the community is to have four branches across the locality (Aldinga, Victor Harbor, Goolwa, and Willunga). This night stood as proof of what can be achieved when a community comes together, and great excitement for what can be achieved in the future.
