



### **Community grants**

At the company's Annual General Meeting, over \$60,000 in Community Grant funding was announced to 25 local projects ranging from youth development, disability care, scholarship programs and new Kindergarten facilities.

Laverton Community Integrated Services, project "Be The Man" was one of the recipients. This program seeks to engage young males, ages 12 – 16 years, who are at risk of disengaging at school, leaving school altogether and/or who are showing signs of offending behaviour, including criminal offences, bullying and violence towards women.

The Karen Baptist Community of Victoria in partnership with the Barnstoneworth United Junior Football Club received a grant. This grant provides the opportunity for young refugees to be introduced to structured and ongoing sporting activity.

The Club is offering refugee youth and their families free or subsidised membership at the Football Club, along with mentoring within established teams. In total, between 10-20 youth, both boys and girls, will join the club and be provided with ongoing support.

The small, worn and sparse outdoor yards at Williams Early Learning Centre in Laverton, successfully received an upgrade thanks to a Community Grant. The grant enabled an engaging outdoor discovery garden for the centre to be built. Dividing fences were removed so siblings can play with each other, boundary trees planted to reduce road noise and sensory yard was installed for the babies.

Congratulations to all the successful organisations.

The Community Grants program has become an annual funding round for community groups. Applications are accessed by a committee of local community members and representatives of the **Community Bank®** branch Board. The 2014 grant program will open in August.
