A new disabled-friendly toilet has been added along the Willow Grove walking track at Blue Rock Lake. Director David Balfour met with the Baw Baw Radiomodellers Association Gippsland and Cr. Michael Leaney to open this new facility.

The portable disabled toilet was partially funded by our Community Investment Program, the Baw Baw Shire Council, and contributions from the Baw Baw Radiomodellers Association itself last year. This facility will be available not only to Club members but also to locals who are enjoying the lake scenery or the walking track and require disabled facilities.


