

Emergency & Community Support



We sponsored the **Community of Yarragon's Good Friday Appeal** in their annual Easter Treasure Hunt.

Emergency & Community Support



The Trafalgar Fire Brigade applied for our Community Investment program to purchase a water pump for hose testing and received \$3,000 in funding.

Trafalgar Fire Brigade volunteers complete annual hose testing on all of the brigade hoses. At the station, volunteers also dedicate their time to repair Trafalgar and Thorpdale Fire Brigades hoses, to guarantee and maintain operational efficiency.

We take pride in supporting our local emergency services and extend our gratitude to them for their invaluable contributions to our community.



We supported the **Willow Grove & District Lions Club** in obtaining a Log Splitter for \$7,190,
which they tell us has made an incredible
difference to their weekly firewood collecting.

It's truly rewarding to support clubs like the Lions Club that, in turn, contribute significantly to the community.



To mark our 20th anniversary, we partnered with **Triple M Gippsland** for an exciting promotional event called "Find the Golden Pig," which was a hit with listeners.

Each pig found entered listeners into a draw for a chance to win \$1,000, courtesy of Triple M and sponsored by Community Bank Trafalgar & District. On the day of our celebration, November 24th, Triple M set up outside our branch. We engaged with the community by handing out giveaways, which were all purchased from local businesses.

There was also a special appearance from our very own Piggy to join in on the celebrations.

Sport & Recreation

Over the past 20 years, we have supported numerous sporting clubs within the Trafalgar & District catchment area. Country sport is highly valued in our region, providing individuals with support, a sense of connection, and significant mental health benefits, contributing to overall well-being and fitness.

We understand the importance of these clubs in our community and are proud to support them.



The **Thorpdale Bowling Club** has seen ongoing contributions to its projects over the years, and we are proud to have been there every step of the way. Our sponsorship allowed the club to proceed with widening the existing verandah concrete area by 1.2 meters, alleviating the congestion bowlers and spectators were experiencing.

In 2023, additional funding helped complete the works with the installation of synthetic grass over the pedestrian pathway. We are delighted to support the Thorpdale Bowling Club and have contributed to the improvement of their facilities which totalled \$7500.



The Baw Baw Radiomodellers Association Gippsland is an RC Model Plane club located at Willow Grove, on the water's edge of Blue Rock Lake. A range of RC airplanes are flown at the club, including scale model planes, trainers, sport planes, aerobatic planes, and even drones and helicopters.

Community Bank Trafalgar & District assisted with sponsorship of \$5,000 for a portable disabled toilet for the club. This important amenity supports the club's senior members and enables the club to be all-abilities inclusive, which is something they were passionate about, and we were eager to support. The toilet is also available to locals in the community who require disabled amenities and want to enjoy the picturesque views of the lake.

The portable disabled toilet was partially funded by our Community Investment Program, the Baw Baw Shire Council, and contributions from the Club itself.

We have been honored to support our local juniors for a number of years. In our 2023 contributions, they were awarded \$5,214 to go towards storage and a trophy cabinet, where they can proudly display the club's achievements as well as effectively use their storage room.



The **Trafalgar Golf Club** has been based at its current location since 1949, boasting a wide range of members from ages 8 to 88. This diversity highlights that golf has no age boundaries and encourages great social, health, and well-being experiences.

We are thrilled to partner with the Trafalgar Golf Club by providing the funding of \$6,091.00 to acquire a new oven for their kitchen. This marks a positive stride in the club's development, offering an upgraded setup for events or casual rounds with friends.



We assisted the **Yarragon Cricket Club** by providing funding of \$4,695 for a bowling machine, which has become a valuable asset to the club. This machine has significantly enhanced the clubs training sessions and improved their performance on game day.

Education & Research



Thorpdale Kindergarten is a small rural preschool providing early childhood education for 3- and 4-year-olds.

We supported Thorpdale Kindergarten with funds of \$3,000 to update and refresh their outdoor maintenance area, which they describe as the "jewel in our crown," and to continue their focus on outdoor play and exploration.

Trafalgar Early Learning Centre were awarded \$900 to the Kindergarten to go towards sensory toys & play equipment for children needing extra sensory support, through play.

Trafalgar Kindergarten strive to be a friendly and open environment inclusive of all children and where families can feel welcomed and valued.

Facilities & Infrastructure



The **Trafalgar High School** Oval was a major and exciting project for both the Trafalgar High School and the **Trafalgar Cricket Club.** The project provides the Cricket Club with a dedicated ground for their junior sides and the 3rd XI team, offering opportunities for junior games and training to be held locally, making travel easier for Trafalgar High students.

Partnered by the Trafalgar Rotary Club, Trafalgar High School received a \$30,000 grant from Community Bank Trafalgar & District making this project possible. The funding enabled the school to install underground drainage, additional drain pits, and proper plumbing systems to manage water flow from surrounding buildings.

Additionally, a successful sponsorship of \$5,000 with the Trafalgar Cricket Club funded the relocation of the cricket pitch at the High School to a more central location. These combined efforts not only enhance the overall functionality of the space but also create a more resilient and versatile environment, supporting a broader range of activities and significantly contributing to the local community's sporting infrastructure.



The **Trafalgar Park Bowls Club is** an incredible asset for the community of Trafalgar and the surrounding areas, serving as a venue for a wide range of community resources and activities.

The Trafalgar Park Bowls Club was successful in obtaining funding of \$5250 which was used for a much-needed spruce-up of the exterior painting of the windows.
